

# NEMT Workshop and Boatshed Policy Directive

## Operational From November 2022

This policy applies to all maritime charitable organisations, groups, individuals and communities equally and without bias wishing to use NEMT facilities.

As a result of ongoing financial climatic conditions this policy is deemed necessary in order to retain the longevity and financial health of NEMT- the following Policy Directives are implemented.

Where work is carried out on behalf of any third parties the following will apply :-

- The use of facilities and buildings will be booked prior to intended use and will be allocated at the discretion of NEMT and charged for at a rate previously agreed
- Any third party labour supplied shall be regarded as experienced; (assessment may be required) and/or skilled enough to carry out works
- Third parties must be insured for public liability and may be held responsible for any personal or material damage to premises and equipment
- Any work carried out by volunteers should be assessed and an appropriate donation made for the upkeep of NEMT premises
- Materials, disposables and additional equipment will be supplied by or at the cost of the third party unless otherwise agreed with NEMT
- Transport of boats and equipment will be the responsibility of the third party

Third party organisations requesting our services will be required to financially compensate this Trust for works carried out on their behalf at agreed rates, plus a discretionary 20% contingency where appropriate.
