When nemt.co.uk and nemaritimetrust.co.uk ran under daily.co.uk, Paul G used to pay the bills but I used to run it under a 'super admin': The_Dog_Watch and I've created one for Alec: chockerblock.

Incidentally I created you as an 'editor': jerry and you both can roam all over the site and do all the editing, deletions etc, as you wish except, Alec can add or remove users. I removed Paul G ages ago.

Before that Paul and I agreed that I would run the site and he would, because he was treasurer, pay for it and we are paid up until October next year.
